SURGE IN FOOD INSECURITY AFTER THE PANDEMIC



Serving 4x the number of meals since before the pandemic



Converting to a hybrid service model in Dining Rooms accommodating both takeaway and indoor dining.



The Mobile Delivery Pilot Program launched in early 2023 has served 27,546 meals to date. LFCC will add 2-6 more partners to serve hot and nutritious meals to more locations than ever before.
