Rising Hunger and Strained Resources



Surge in Demand: With the end of pandemic-era relief programs, LFCC has experienced a sharp rise in requests for meals and grocery support.



Widespread Food Insecurity: In Contra Costa County, 1 in 7 residents and 1 in 5 children lack consistent access to nutritious food. Hunger affects not only the unemployed, but also seniors on fixed incomes, single-parent households, BIPOC communities, and working families struggling with rising costs. (UWCA, Real Cost Measure 2025)



Seniors at Risk: In Contra Costa County, food insecurity is now the number one concern among older adults, with many struggling to afford or access nutritious meals since the pandemic. (Contra Costa County Area Plan on Aging 2020-2024)



Funding and Supply Threats: Federal and state budget cuts to Medicaid, Medi-Cal, SNAP, and CalFresh are reducing benefits for millions, further straining safety nets and limiting LFCC's capacity to meet growing demand.
